


Most of French PhD theses and dissertations granted since 2006 are ETDs - A centralised framework based on a national legislation - 3 free softwares designed by the "Agence bibliographique de l'enseignement supérieur" (ABES): STAR, STEP and theses.fr - More than 130 universities and "grandes écoles" use theses softwares - The whole-life cycle of PhDs is taken into account: before the defence (STEP) and after (STAR)




































